## TUITION AND FEE SCHEDULE – 2008-2009 SCHOOL YEAR

### Basic Tuition

Middle School - \$11,500 per year

High School - \$12,500 per year

### Fixed Fees

Full Year - \$1500

One Semester - \$750

### Tuition Breakdown by Quarter of Enrollment

	Middle School (MS)	High School (HS)
Full Year	\$13,000 (11,500 + 1,500)	\$14,000 (12,500 + 1,500)
3 Quarters	\$10,125 (8,625 + 1,500)	\$10,875 (9,375 + 1,500)
1 Semester	\$6,500 (5,750 + 750)	\$7,000 (6,250 + 750)
1 Quarter	\$3,625 (2,875 + 750)	\$3,875 (3,125 + 750)

\$1,000 deposit due upon submission of enrollment contract. This deposit is applied toward tuition total due.

### Payment Options

Full tuition and fees paid prior to May 1 will receive a 3% reduction in total amount due (*MS \$390, HS \$420*).

Full tuition and fees paid in 4 equal payments of \$3,000 MS or \$3,250 HS due on May 1, June 1, July 1 and August 1 are interest free.

Full tuition and fees paid in 8 payments of \$1,500 MS or \$1,625 HS, plus 1% interest on the unpaid balance, due monthly from May 1 to December 1.

Part year tuition and fee payment schedule arrangements may be requested in writing to the Board of Directors, and are subject to their written agreement.

### Financial Aid

Financial aid is available on both a need and merit basis. Scholarships are awarded at the beginning of the academic year, based upon scholarship funds available, and the recommendation of a committee composed of faculty and members of the Board of Directors. Thus, few scholarships are normally available for students enrolling in mid-year.

Merit scholarships are based upon assessments of demonstrated achievement and aptitude, in accordance with criteria established by the Board of Directors.

Applications for need based financial aid should be made at the time of application or annually at time of tuition contract renewal. Individual need is evaluated and determined for every school year, independently through the National Association of Independent Schools SSS need evaluation process. NAIS communicates need determination information directly to the school.
